6. I will treat council equipment and the college or university equipment with care. I understand that I will be assessed for damages to this equipment in the event that my use of such equipment is negligent or abusive.
7. I will join my fellow participants in practicing the Boy Scout and Girl Scout laws at this event.
8. I understand that at times the activities will be physically and mentally demanding, but that these demands will be to my benefit as well as the groups.
9. I understand that if I am sent home early due to any serious misconduct, it will be at my parents (guardians) expense and that the AISA sponsors will make the travel arrangements and notify my parents of those plans.
10. I will wear event-appropriate dress at all times, which includes traditional dress, the official uniform, or any BSA GSUSA and AISA t-shirt.
